Fotis is an Associate Professor at the HCI Laboratory at Masaryk University, Faculty of Informatics at Brno. Before, he was the director of Interactive Worlds Applied Research Group (iWARG), Faculty of Engineering and Computing at Coventry University and a research fellow at the Serious Games Institute (SGI).

Fotis have contributed to more than 100 refereed publications with more than 2342 citations (h-index: 24 and i10-index: 43) and has been invited 60 times to become member of international conference committees and has chaired 16 sessions in 11 international conferences. He has organised multiple conferences and workshops and he is the co-founder of the IEEE VS-Games international conference. Finally, he is a member of IEEE, ACM and Eurographics.
