After returning to Germany she started working at the Institute for Museum Research (Prussian Cultural Heritage Foundation) being responsible for all museums participating at the online platform Deutsche Digitale Bibliothek (German Digital Library). Central part of this work is meta data mapping and the development of the data exchange format for museum objects (LIDO).
