Key areas of Expertise in Digital Heritage: Cultural information management, intelligent cultural interfaces and environments, personalization of cultural experiences.

Dr. Manolis Wallace [http://gav.uop.gr/wallace/], Assistant Professor at the Department of Informatics and Telecommunications and Director of the Knowledge and Uncertainty Research Laboratory (FAB LAB) [http://gav.uop.gr/], has a long experience in the management of educational and research organizations from his previous tenures at the University of Indianapolis and at the Foundation of the Hellenic World. He now transfers this experience to Tripolis and the University of Peloponnese.

In his tenure at the Foundation of the Hellenic World he supervised the implementation of CH related projects of a cumulative budget exceeding 10Meuros. Currently, at the University of the Peloponnese, he leads an interdisciplinary team including researchers from IT, researchers from the humanities as well as the local Ephorate of Antiquities, jointly working towards using technology for the understanding of cultural heritage and its presentation to the broader public.

He is currently involved in the CrossCult H2020 project as well as a number of national projects in the field of cultural informatics.
