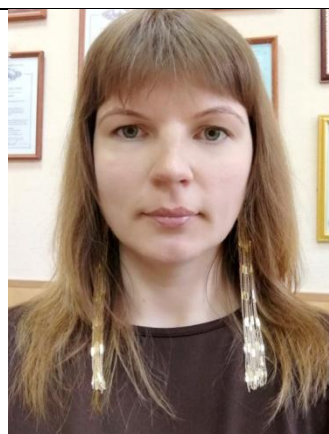

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My scientific interests relate to the theory of virtual museums as well as practice. The main topics of my current research and publications concern the phenomena of virtual museums and VMs as information resources, including possibilities and obstacles of usage of digital resources of VMs in the fields of Humanities, Education, Arts etc.

I work at the Center for Digital Humanities of Perm State University, Russia, where the project "[History-oriented information systems](#)" was initiated. This project has a mission to document different information resources of Digital Cultural Heritage. I participated in designing the information system, developing metadata description, and filling the catalogue of resources.

The Center also has partnership relations with Perm University's History Museum. I take part in developing the Museum's digital infrastructure, and creating 3D models of the most valuable exhibits on the basis of photogrammetric technology. As Associate Professor of the University I teach courses for Masters (mainly) and Bachelors related to Digital Heritage and Virtual Museums.



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
