Nausikää El-Mecky specialises in attacks on art from Antiquity until today. She received her PhD in art history from the University of Cambridge in 2013. Since 2015, she is a post-doctoral fellow at the HSE (Heidelberg University). She is an expert for the European Commission's Creative Europe Programme and has recently been elected a member of the Junge Akademie der Wissenschaften in Berlin. In November 2017, she received the Maria Gräfin von Linden Award for outstanding didactic and academic contributions in the Humanities. Nausikää El-Mecky has contributed, amongst others, to *Apollo*, *Marginalia* | *Los Angeles Review of Books*, *Proceedings of the American Philosophical Society* and *Fotogeschichte*.
