Pierre GRUSSENMEYER is Full Professor at INSA Strasbourg (Graduate School of Science and Technology), France.

He received the Engineer degree (Master) in Geodetic Surveying and Topography in 1984 from ENSAIS, currently INSA Strasbourg (a Graduate School of Science and Technology), and a Ph.D. degree in photogrammetry in 1994 from the University of Strasbourg (in relationship with IGN, Paris). He founded the Photogrammetry and Geomatics Group at INSA Strasbourg (France) in 1996 and is leading this Group since then. His group is affiliated to the ICUBE UMR 7357 Laboratory (The Engineering Science, Computer Science and Imaging Laboratory) of the University of Strasbourg since 2013. Within the ICUBE Laboratory, he is deputy director of the TRIO research team which includes the Photogrammetry and Geomatics Group from INSA.

He is lecturing to graduates at INSA Strasbourg at the Department of Civil Engineering and Surveying: photogrammetry, geodetic astronomy, cultural heritage documentation, imagery and virtual models, initiation to Research.

He was the Director of the CIPA 2013 Symposium about Cultural Heritage Documentation in Strasbourg (300 participants from 40 countries). In 2016, he co-chaired the EuroMed Conference in Nicosia (Cyprus). He is also involved as a co-chair in the organization of the ISPRS 2020 Congress to be held in Nice (France). He is also member of the Editorial Board of the Photogrammetric Record (an International Journal of Photogrammetry).

He is active in several scientific Societies:

- CIPA: the ISPRS and ICOMOS International Committee for Cultural Heritage documentation (member of the board since 1999, treasurer from 1999 to 2010, Symposium Director in 2013, participation to Summer Schools)
- ISPRS: Chairman of two Working Groups between 2000 and 2008.
- AFT: Association Française de Topographie (Vice-president) and active member of the Editorial board of the XYZ Journal.

55 papers in international (31) and national (24) journals, 1 book (translation), 3 Symposia proceedings and 2 journals (editor), 12 book chapters (architectural photogrammetry and applications in Cultural Heritage), 35 invited talks or seminars, and 149 conference papers in international (140) and national (9) events, supervisor of 19 PhDs, 3 on-going PhDs.
