In her role of Curator of New Media and Head of the Internet Office at The Israel Museum, Jerusalem, Hazan's responsibilities include: identifying, and implementing digital solutions for the gallery, online and mobile platforms and outreach programs. Her Masters and PhD at Goldsmiths College, (2004) University of London in Media and Communications focused on electronic architectures in the contemporary museum. Hazan has been recognized for her numerous publications on new media in education, art, museums and cultural heritage, and is currently investigating social networks, innovative platforms for disseminating virtual museum, and digital libraries in the context of cultural heritage.

Participated as active partner in several EU projects, such as FP7 ViMM project. She is chairing now the ViMM TA1/WG1 experts, focusing on the modern definition of Virtual Museums.
