Key areas of Expertise in Digital Heritage:

Thomas Reuter is a surveyor at the Archaeological Heritage Office of Saxony in Germany. He is responsible for the 3d documentation of archaeological finds employing a range of different close range scanners. A main part is the development of workflows for digitizing archaeological finds with different materials, sizes and preservation status. Since 2012 he is part of the EU-funded german-czech project ArcheoMontan, which aims at researching medieval mining in the Ore Mountains area and Northern Bohemia.
